# Chain of Responsibility Policy

Energy Power Systems Australia (EPSA) is committed to conducting its business in compliance with all relevant National and State laws and regulations, including Chain of Responsibility (CoR) legislation.

EPSA aims to provide a safe and compliant work environment for all employees, contractors, and the public, insofar as is reasonably practicable.

Our 'Values and Behaviours' statement reflects our expectations: Safety and Wellbeing - First and always.

EPSA will endeavour to:

- Have in place a risk assessment process to identify, evaluate and control risks associated with heavy vehicle transport activities;
- Comply with all mass, dimension, restraint, loading and unloading requirements under CoR legislation;
- Do everything reasonably practicable to ensure all heavy vehicle service providers procured for transport activities have safety management systems and processes in place to meet their obligations under CoR legislation;
- Educate employees and contractors involved in transport activities on their responsibilities under CoR legislation; and
- Ensure that employees, contractors or third-party suppliers with responsibilities for activities that affect compliance with this policy, EPSA procedures, and CoR legislation are held accountable for any breach in their responsibilities.

While all employees and contractors involved in heavy vehicle transport activities are directly responsible for ensuring that they understand and comply with their CoR responsibilities, we recognise the role of our management team in creating a safe and healthy work environment through having appropriate working conditions, safety culture, and management systems in place insofar as is reasonably practicable to meet the intentions of this policy.
